 World Population Day is an annual event, observed on July 11 every year, which seeks to raise awareness of global population issues.

 The event was established by the Governing Council of the UNDP in 1989. It was inspired by the public interest in Five Billion Day on July 11, 1987 approximately the date on which the world's population reached five billion people.

- The Theme of World Population Day 2014 is "Investing in Young People."
- There are 1.8 billion people aged 10-24 in the world, making one quarter of the world's population. This group comprises adolescents (aged 10-19) and youth (aged 15-24).
- Investing in young people today by promoting healthy habits and ensuring education and employment opportunities, access to health services, and social security coverage for all workers is the best investment to improve the lives of future generations.
