Why DRR as part of Development?

- Development is intended to improve lives and livelihoods
- If development is damaged by disaster it fails to achieve goals
- Poorly designed development can contribute to disasters
- In other words: DRR <u>is</u> development

DRR Integration

- Policy of many donors
- Can improve impact, reduce costs by avoiding damage from disasters
- Better to prevent or minimize disasters than fund relief and recovery
- Strengthens overall sustainability and social resilience

Learning by Doing

- Focused first on UNDP
- Assessed DRR links and options in UNDP portfolio
- Developed process to assess project-DRR links and integrate DRR options into projects
- Considered <u>operations</u> and <u>assistance provided</u>

- 1. Training (5-7 hrs)
- 2. Assess hazards, vulnerability and risks
- Development Project Disaster Management Plan
 Office Safety Checklist
- 4. Risk issues addressed
- 5. Field level risk management checklists completed on a routine basis.
- 6. Natural Hazard Assessment Report Infrastructure Projects reports completed on a routine basis.
- Certification documentation submitted for approval
- 8. Disaster Risk Reduction Certification or Recertification approved

- Another thing to do!
- Where does it say DRR is an institutional priority?
- Show me the benefits!
- Better done during design than in middle of a project
- Some specialists help needed to guide process
- Who is responsible?
- Can an organization sustain the process?
