

## Situational Report # 2

### Flooding in East Khatlon Region

#### I. Latest Overview

The flooding continues to affect the areas of Voce, Kulyab, Shurabad, Hovaling and Muminobad districts of East Khatlon.

Based on the information received from CoEs assessment team and local authorities as of 17:00 April 13, 2010, some areas are still not accessible to evaluate damages. However, the initial assessment of 136 households in Voce district indicates that at least 78 houses have potential to structural collapse in just a week's time due to their construction characteristics. Most of the houses are adobe built and do not have foundations. Several houses have already been completely destroyed in Voce districts. Strong wind affected some areas in Voce district, damaging roofs of 70 houses.

Kulyab CoEs dispatched additional staff to evaluate areas Shurabad, Hovaling, Baljuvan and Kulyab districts.

The water levels now subsided, but remaining waters still pose significant risk to the communities.

#### II. Damage Information

Voce district continues to severely affected area. However, assessments by CoEs team in Shurabad, Muminabad, Baljuvan and Khovaling are still in progress. Preliminary damage reports are illustrated in the table below:

### III. Assistance Provided/ Measures Taken

- Affected population of Kuchabogh and Kashar are still receiving food collected as donations from the neighboring community.
- Bridge was repaired in Kuchabogh allowing limited vehicle access to the village.
- Local rescue brigades are still on duty.
- CoEs and local authorities are assessing the damage in the areas, as they become accessible.
- Local Red Crescent Society provided tents for the 14 affected HH whose houses were completely destroyed. Oxfam provided fuel for CoEs tent distribution team.
- Storage space is available at local Jamoat for non perishable items, as it was indicated during coordination meeting this afternoon.

### IV. Needs

The following requirements for assistance have been identified as the first priority:

- Additional tents required for the houses near collapse
- Construction material will be required for rehabilitating the houses once the flood waters become less risky
- Joint needs assessment needs to be conducted in Shurabad and Khovaling
