

## Situational Report # 4

### Flooding in East Khatlon Region

#### I. Latest Overview

The water level is elevated in YuokhSu River putting at risk of flood more villages in Vose.

The rainy weather brought more flood to Jarcheap 2 area of Muminabad district at 3 a.m bringing more damages to families.

Increase in transport fare from Voce to Kulyab city makes it hard for students and other residents to afford daily travel.

The internal roads aren't accessible for the vehicles within the villages due to high level of clay. It currently causes difficulties for the people to transport their commodities to and from market.

In Kulyab district, school #44 located in Yokhsuchiyon village of Dahana Jamoat affected by the flood. About 40 meters of the schoolyard walls collapsed as a result of flood. 80% of 210 meters dam built by Mission East is in ruins. 120 meters of pipes that supplied drinking water to Yokhsuchiyon village has been damaged and moved by flood waters. The local community currently uses water from the spring in the village.

### III. Assistance Provided/ Measures Taken

- CoEs and local authorities continue to assess damage in the areas, a coordination meeting of all govt agencies was held in Voce Hukumat to discuss the damage. Complete list of affected HH and infrastructure will be ready tomorrow.
- Oxfam GB distributed nutritional items, purification tablets and soap to children provided by Unicef. Assistance was provided to 16 HH with significant damages (over 80%) in Jarchep 2 village (Tutu Jamoat) of Muminabad and to 79 HH in Tugarak Jamoat of Voce.
- REACT Kulyab Situational Assessment planned for Shurabad district in the village of Dashti Jum has been postponed due to weather conditions
- Red Crescent is currently conducting needs assessment in Muminabad
- Cluster assessment planned for April 20.

### IV. Needs

#### Shelter:

- Instruments for cleaning out debris and mud are required
- Construction materials for roof restoration
- Tents for those whose houses are completely destroyed

**WASH:**

- Assessment on water sanitation system
- Immediate needs for water purification

**Food Security:**

- Assessment on food security and impact on livelihoods
- Immediate needs for supporting feeding areas
