

Situational Report # 6

Flooding in East Khatlon Region

I. Latest Overview

In the result of the rains the water level in Yokhsu and Surkhob is increasing.

On **17.04.2010** at 11:00 AM the irrigation canal which situates in the top of **Tugarak** village, jamoat of Tugarak filled with the mudflow and flood damaged 100 households. Fool access for conducting damage assessment due to mudflow in the streets of the village is restricted.

In the same day mudflow damaged 30 housholds of **Karaghoch** village, jamoat of Tugarak, Vose district.

3 houses in this village are partly damaged. The roads inside of the village are filled with the sediment.

In **Guliston** village, jamoat of Kurbonshaid, Vose district hail and mudflow damaged 130 households, agricultural land were filled with the clay and more then 100 domestic animals were killed by the mudflow.

According to the information of CoES of Kulyab zone due to heavy rains 30 households of center of jamoat of **Sarichashma**, Shuroobod district were effected by the mudflow. Kitchen gardens are filled with the clay, some domestic animals also were killed by the mudflow.

Today at 4 AM due to heavy rain mudflow damaged 160 households of Kurbonshaid village, jamoat of Kurbonshaid, Vose district. Mostly mudflow damaged kitchen gardens, roads and kitchens, sheds are filled with the clay. Community are trying to maintenance the irrigation canals.

12 hoseholds of **Oqmazor** village, jamoat of Chubek of Hamadoni district were damaged by the mudflow on 18. 04. 2010.
