


Situation report Nº 2 05 January 2010

Earthquake in Vanj District, GBAO Tajikistan

Situation overview

Damage and needs assessment is still on-going and is being carried out by representatives of Local Disaster Management Commission (LDMC), and number of REACT partners, namely: National Red Crescent Society of Tajikistan (RCST), WFP, FOCUS Humanitarian Assistance and representatives of REACT Secretariat in Dushanbe. Considering the fact that assessment has not been completed so far, figures on damage caused are slightly changing. According to the latest information received from the site, total of 140 houses (with approximately 700 residents) are considered to be fully destroyed. Another 921 homes (with 6215 residents) are partially affected.

Residents of the fully destroyed houses are currently evacuated to local mosques, schools and houses of neighbors and relatives. According to Ministry of Health several medical points, including Vanj Central District Hospital have been damaged, nevertheless are still operational, except of District Health Center (outpatient clinic), which is seriously damaged and non-functional.

Secondary schools # 4, 5 and music school # 1 in Vanj district center have been damaged, however assessments indicated that premises can still be used.

Mr. Oqil Oqikov, Prime Minister and Mr. Haibullo Latipov, Chairman of CoES were on sight today coordinating disaster assessment. During the LDMC meeting chaired by Prime Minister a decision was taken that following the completion of the assessment, new land spots will be allocated to families whose houses are fully destroyed.

The LDMC is chaired by District Head, Mr. Jonov Narzullo, and is currently located in the building of the Vanj district Hukumat. All the relevant civil services are currently mobilized and involved in response operations.

Needs Information

On January 4, 2010, Committee of Emergency Situations and Civil Defense has requested assistance in the form of:

_	Winter tents	200 pcs
_	Kitchen sets	150 set
_	Hygienic sets	600 set
_	Warm clothes	600 set
_	Blankets	600 pcs
-	Bedding sets (linen, mattresses)	600 set
_	Food items: flour, oil, rice, sugar	not specified

During the meeting of LDMC, chaired by the Prime Minister with the participation of various state and REACT representatives, government strongly requested assistance in reconstruction of homes for families which are left homeless.



Response provided and committed

- Government of Tajikistan has provided 25 MT of basic food commodities: flour (5 MT), rice (5MT), sugar (5MT), macaroni (5MT) and vegetable oil (5MT);
- Red Crescent Society of Tajikistan has distributed 7 spring/autumn tents and 25 sets of non-food items. In addition, tomorrow morning (6 January 2010) following items will be transported from Dushanbe to disaster site:
 - Bedding for 73 families;
 - Winterized tents 47;
 - Hygiene kits 73;
 - Kitchen sets 73;
 - Second Hand clothes;
 - Water cans 73;
 - Stoves (wood, gas) 73;
 - Candles for 73 households;
- 50 winterized tents have been released from UN Emergency Reserve and is expected to reach Vanj on 05 January 2010;
- UNICEF will deliver following items, to disaster site, tomorrow, 6 January 2010:
 - Blankets (baby) 250 pcs;
 - Blankets (adult) 250 pcs;
 - High protein biscuits 250 boxes;
 - Bed linen (adult) 250 pcs;
 - Bed linen (baby) 250 pcs;
 - Therapeutic spread 50 boxes;
 - Basic emergency health kit 2 units;
 - Water purification tablets 100 packs;
- GTZ has committed to allocate Euro 10,000 for purchase of relief items. Currently local procurement of relief items is on-going, which are expected to be dispatched on 06 January.


<u>Annex I: Detailed map of affected villages in Vanj District</u> (Map developed by Information Management and Analytical Center of CoES)
