The Deputy Chief of CoES and CD of Khatlon Province Mr. Halimov M.T opened the meeting and welcomed the participants. He mentioned the importance of joint meeting with REACT partners from Kyrgyz Republic which would give positive outcome and experience sharing on emergency situations and response.

The REACT group with the cooperation of CoES and CD operatively acts during emergency situations and support the suffered people with the first aid and other necessary inputs. Thus Mr. Halimov listed the REACT group of Khatlon province to the representatives of Kyrgyz REACT underlining effective integration and cooperation of local governments and CoES and CD on provincial level (REACT Partners in Khatlon WFP, OXFAM, OSCE, ACTED, RCST, Save the Children, Nuri Khatlon, UNDP, CoES and CD).

Referring to the function of the REACT Mrs. Shahlo Rahimova from the UNDP/DRMP National Focal Point added

brief information demonstrating the map of Tajikistan and explaining the operational areas of REACT.

Also, Mrs. Rahimova noted overall objective of REACT to Kyrgyz partners, which is to strengthen joint efforts in disaster management in Tajikistan by improving the coordination and information sharing amongst all partners and communities, and to strengthen the Committee of Emergency Situations leadership of the activities. More specifically, REACT with the CoES is to assist and cooperate with the Government of Tajikistan, Civil Society, and the International Community, to meet their responsibilities to cope with natural disasters. Under the leadership of CoES, REACT partners will coordinate disaster response as well as all disaster risk reduction activities.

A video has been demonstrated with the coverage of Kulyab Flooding of 2009 which followed by a free flow discussion on the response, recovery and coordination amongst the government counterparts, local and international NGOs and other REACT partners during the above mentioned natural disaster. Ms. Jamilia Abdunasyrova, a representative from Kyrgyz Delegation showed a concern regarding pregnant women and asked the type of support and assistance they receive during the emergency situations when they go into the initial stage of labor. In this regard Mrs. Rahimova added that during the emergency situations mobile vehicles from the local hospitals are utilized on sites for assisting such cases which would require immediate attention.

In the meanwhile Mr. Firuz Huseinov from the CoES and CD of Khatlon Province questioned Kyrgyz REACT partners how they would evaluate the post-disaster points in the affected areas. Mrs. Mira Yakupova, from Kyrgyz partners responded by saying that first of all the evaluation will be conducted visually and then with specialized people who will be able to identify the value and volume of the losses and damages. Shuhrat Khodjaev a representative of UN/WFP, a local REACT partner, mentioned the active cooperation of REACT with national and local government in response and recovery of spring floods in Kulyab of 2009, which reflected a good example of close cooperation amongst many organizations offering and proving assistance in support of suffered community.
