**1. Introduction by Mr. Muzzayanova X, Deputy Chief of Headquarters of Emergency Situations and Civil Defense in Sugd region. (5 minutes)**

Mr. Muzzayanov greeted all participants to regular meeting of REACT in Sugd region and introduced new participants in the meeting from the State organizations of Sugd region

**2. An overview of information about emergency situations in the territory of Sugd region for February-March 2011 (5 min) - Muzzayanov H. Deputy Chief of Headquarter of Emergency Situations and Civil Defense in Sugd region**

According to the information of the Headquarters of ES and Civil Defense in Sugd region in the territory of Sugd region three emergency situations were recorded: car accidents on the highway of Dusanbe-Chanak—in the territory of Shahrستان district—which caused the death of 4 people.

**3. The overview of water resources management in the aspect of emergency situations in Sugd region - Representative of the Office of Water Resources in Sugd region (20 min)**

There was a brief report of the Office of Water Resources in Sugd region about the damage of water sector in Emergencies. The main damage was caused by mudflows in Asht, Spitamen, J. Rasulov, B. Gafurov and Kanibadam districts. It was stressed particularly that because of washout of dams along the coast of Kayrakkum reservoir several hundred hectares of land became unfit for cultivation. It was particularly stressed that first of all it is necessary to pay attention to bank protection works in the Isfana say, Hoji Bakirgan say, etc.

**4. Presentation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> edition of the magazine “EcoSodruzhestvo”--“Best Practices on Emergency Situations and Adaptation to Climate Change” - Suleimanov E. editor in chief (15 min)**

The second edition of the magazine "Ekosodruzhestvo" which presented articles and best practices of five organizations of Tajikistan on disaster preparedness and adaptation to climate change was presented by Mr. Suleymanov,. It must be noted that, in comparison with 1<sup>st</sup> edition of the magazine, in this edition there is more local information, intended primarily for ordinary readers (farmers, local government bodies, NGOs, etc.). **5. Presentation of the educational film on radiation safety within the project of CASE / OSCE « Informational Campaign on Radiation Safety in Taboshar, Zokirov I. NGO " Action for Life" (20 min)**

The educational documentary film on radiation safety was shown by Sugd regional TV and NGO "Action for Life". The film is, almost completely, shot in Taboshar and tells about the negative impact of radiation on human health and environment. It should, also, be noted that the film presents specific recommendations for individual protection against radiation and provides specific advice to the local population of Taboshar about grazing cattle in prohibited places close to the tailing of the city. It should be noted that the authors of the film prepared Tajik, Russian and Uzbek version of the film, which will greatly facilitate the access to important environmental information for local populations.

Emergency situations and Civil Defense headquarter in Sugd region informed the members of REACT group on Sugd region that it is planned to hold emergency situations exercises in Ayni district in May.
