1. Introduction by Chair, Mr. Kodirberdiev, Deputy Head of DoES and CD in Sughd Region

The chair of the meeting welcomed all participants of the 9th Sughd- REACT meeting.

2. Disaster information and updates

On June 22 in the result of torrential rain there was a mudflow in Jamoat Oshoba. The height of the mudflow was about 15-20 m.

12 people killed, 10 injured

85 households damaged - 294 people

14 houses damaged (8 completely, 6 partially)

Khukumat of Sughd oblast – for each lost person's families were provided 1000 somoni (total 12.000 somoni), for 10 injured people's treatment - 5000 somoni

Khukumat of Asht district – for each lost person's families were provided 400 somoni (total 4.800 somoni), 2 sacks of wheat flour, 1 sack of rice, 20 kg of oil;

Red Crescent Society provided tents, household items.

Additional aid is expected from towns and districts of Sughd oblast.

Damage amount is being calculated and will be provided soon to the REACT Secretariat.

Mr. Frank Paepke mentioned about necessity of effective communication for more concise and transparent work of REACT. He suggested reconsidering and adding information to the current database on reserve fund based on existing resources and capabilities of each organization. GAA has neither food products nor non-food items, but it can provide transport and conduct organizational issues.

Mr. Sharafutdinov made a note an existing problem which threatens the large population with natural disasters, in particular in Asht, Ghanchi and Shakhristan districts. This is related with the mass trees cutting and constructing houses in hazard areas. In this connection he proposed to unite capacities and work actively in preparedness and reducing risks of natural disasters and recommended to organizations to work in 2 directions in future:

1. Elaboration of ecological hazard maps.
2. Planting trees in eminences.

3. Detailed information about drowned people and measures to prevent accidents

Colonel Rakhimov briefly presented information about drowned people for the first half year and mentioned about the reasons of high rate. After the meeting GAA employees and colonel Rakhimov will be working on developing project request to the German Embassy. The results will be presented during the next meeting.

4. Organizational issues of REACT group - place, time and agenda for the next meeting

The next meeting was planned for 29 August, 2007 at 10:00. Place of the meeting will be agreed later.
