# Flood in Surkhob River

# General Information

- Total population of the village: 530 persons (83 families)
- Total affected: 214 persons (80 male/134 female)
- Total families affected: 44

# General Information (2)

- Houses affected:
  - Fully destroyed: 4
  - Partially affected: 28 (currently residents are demolishing the buildings)
- Social and public services:
  - Local school and healthcare point are functioning without interruption;



# Assistance Provided

- Local Khukumat:
  - Area for temporary tent camp;
  - Land spots for relocation of the affected families;
  - Hot food (for those who lost their houses)
  - Labour support (for evacuation of property to safe locations and demolishing of the houses);
  - Delivery of drinking water;

# Assistance Provided (2)

- Red Crescent Society Kulyab Branch:
  - Tents;
  - Kitchen sets;
  - Hygiene sets;
  - First Aid Kits;
  - Plows and spades;
  - Water tanks, buckets;
  - Electrical wire, blankets.

(Only for ten households)



# Needs Information

- Additional 30 tents;
- Drinking water delivery (there is an 8 km distance between the reservoir and the tent camp);
- Food aid;
- Additional kitchen sets, blankets, hygiene sets
