

Disaster Response

Spring Avalanches and Mudflows in GBAO

- In cooperation with CoES monitored avalanche and mudflows situation in GBAO and provided daily situation update to the partners
- AKDN/FOCUS provided assistance to local authorities to reopen strategic roads in GBAO blocked by avalanches
- AKDN/FOCUS dispatched medicine to blocked Murghab district via helicopter
- FOCUS through Community Emergency Response Teams (CERTS) were on high alert and in cooperation with CoES supported affected households

Disaster Response

Mud flow in Riddeh village of Rushan District, GBAO

- Assessed the situation in collaboration with CoES GBAO
- Supported CoES and local authorities in evacuation of the population to safe area
- -Provided fuel and lubricants for protection measures in the village
- -Provide tents, matrasses and blankets for evacuated people
- -Constructed retaining wall

Landslide threat in Tsotrzh village of Roshtkala district

- In collaboration with CoES evacuated 4 household form risk zone and provided tents
- Hydro-insulated the irrigation channel which was the sources of the landslide

Outcomes

- Communities are able to identify risks and are aware of hazards and respond to disasters
- The government's agencies capacity is enhanced to assess, prepare and respond to disasters and have increased knowledge about application of new technologies such as GIS and Remote Sensing
- Structural mitigation projects are in place to protect the communities from disasters, loss of assets and lives
- Community Emergency Response Teams trained to act as first responders during the emergencies
- Communities supported in overcoming negative results of emergencies/disasters
