
RCST Response to humanitarian needs in GBAO



Starting of responce: 24th July **2012**

At HQ level

- Coordination meetings with IFRC, ICRC, PNS, WFP, WHO, FOCUS, UNDP DRMP, UNICEF, UNOCHA, GIZ
- Process of call for Disaster Response Emergency Funds was started (DREF)

At Khorog branch level

- Staff and volunteers were mobilized (12 NDRT and 48 volunteers)
- Situation and needs assessments
- Rendering First aid to affected and wounded population
- Distribution of non-food items to affected population was started
- Distribution of first aid kits to affected families was started
- List of beneficiaries to be prepared





RESULTS

- Needs assessment was conducted in 6 micro-districts
- First aid was rendered to over 150 people
- Over 10 families were assisted with NFIs
- 130 First aid kits were distributed to most affected families
- With the support of the ICRC, 50 first aid kits for RCST volunteers, one medical kit for war wounded (1,100 kg of dressing material and specialized drugs for 50 injured patients) and 522 bed-linens were transported from Dushanbe to Khorugh city branch and donated to the regional hospital of Badakshan
- Disaster response emergency funds (DREF) was received
- Coordination mechanism with stakeholders was established
- List of 1,620 beneficiaries was prepared in cooperation and agreement with local government and representatives of affected sites

RCST Plans

- Provision of supplementary food parcels for 1,620 affected families (9,720 people) in Khorugh city.
- Provision of hygiene kits for 1,620 affected families (9,720 people) in Khorugh city.
- Psychosocial support will be rendered to some 7,000 people who were worst affected by the recent events in GBAO.
